9 10	<i>Recognizing</i> each Member-States' initial commitment and desire for progress on the Millennium Development Goals,

12 13	<i>Taking into consideration</i> the progress made on some aspects of Goal 3, such as an increase in primary education for women,

15	<i>Concerned</i> with the lack of progress in other aspects of Goal 3, such as the low
16 17	percentage of women in high ranking positions within Member States,
18	Commending the work previously accomplished by Member States on the
19	Millennium Development Goals,
20 21	1. Calls upon Member States to reaffirm their commitment to the Millennium
21	Development Goals and reestablish their initial fervor toward the completion of the
23 24	Millennium Development Goals;
24 25	2. Notes the body's original goal aspiration to accomplish the Millennium
26	Development Goals by 2015;

28	3. <i>Encourages</i> Member States to coordinate with the United Nations Development
