SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy Review SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent) The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent), *Recognizing* the growing link between organized crime, arms dealing, drug trafficking, and terrorism, Acknowledging the globalization of both terrorism and financial markets, Seeking to disrupt the funding of terrorist organizations, Recognizing that the combination of terrorist organizations and organized crime expands the scope, resources and capabilities of terrorists, Appreciating the International Monetary Fund's anti-money laundering efforts, 1. Encourages Member States to act swiftly and firmly when confronted with instances of terrorist related money laundering; 2. Calls upon the nations of the world to regulate and audit their banks with the intention of obstructing money laundering and strictly abide by all relevant treaties they have signed to this effect; 3. *Urges* those nations that have had a problem with their financial institutions being used to launder terrorist funds to use resources available to them through the International Monetary Fund and other organizations; 4. Recommends that nations take advantage of the resources that the International Monetary Fund makes available to combat terrorist related money laundering; 5. *Urges* nations to engage in information sharing to coordinate investigations.
