## **Historical Security Council -- 1956**

## Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 14 July 1956, in connection with the Council's Consideration of the item entitled The situation in Egypt, the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

- 1 The United Nations Security Council condemns the restriction of trade by the Egyptian
- 2 military. If they permit trade for all legal vessels through the canal and the Straight of
- 3 Tiran, the United States and the United Kingdom agree to resume funding for the Aswan
- 4 Dam Project.

- 6 Additionally, the Security Council demands Israel cease all aggressive actions against its
- 7 neighbors and allow the right of return for Palestinian refugees.

Passed by consensus, with 3 abstentions
