SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION:Outcome document of the Special Event to follow-up efforts made
towards achieving the Millennium Development GoalsSUBMITTED TO:The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent)

The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent),

1 *Concerned* with the complications developing countries may have had with the implementation of the Mil-2 lennium Development Goals due to funding constraints,

3 Understanding the need for a unified effort to achieve Millennium Development Goals,

4 *Expressing* its appreciation for the donations which were given to developing nations by the Development 5 Assistance Committee,

6 *Recognizing* the role of Non-Governmental Organizations and the private sector in aiding developing nations 7 to achieve the goals set by the body,

8 *Noting with concern* the prevalence of corruption in governmental bodies despite collective efforts to monitor 9 the allocation of aid funding,

10 *Having examined* the past funding structure in place for the Millennium Development Goals and finding it 11 lacking,

12 1. *Encourages* the International Monetary Fund to increase its aid funding for developing nations;

13 2. *Recommends* Member States support a policy by which aid funding to developing nations will be increased 14 in order to reach the goals set forth by this committee as related to the Millennium Development Goals and their 15 successors until the time that these goals are achieved;

16 3. *Further invites* the inclusion of Non-Governmental Organizations and the private sector entities in the 17 process of procurring funding;

4. *Strongly recommends* that the UN Convention Against Corruption criminalize the misuse of aid funds and establish a committee devoted to the monitoring of the use of aid funds.
