Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 1st of March, 1994, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "Situation in Rwanda," the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

The United Nations Security Council calls on all sides and parties in Rwanda to avoid divisive rhetoric in 4 order to calm present tensions and allow the required space for civil society to develop. Inflaming tensions threatenes 5 the livelihood of all Rwandans with the promise of unnecessary violence and destroys the progress of Rwanda towards 6 a more just and prosperous society. The Security Council urges all sides and parties in Rwanda to utilize constructive language as the situations develop.

The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
