Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 24 November 2017, in connection with the Council's con-2 sideration of the item entitled Nuclear Nonproliferation, the President of the Security Council made the following 3 statement on behalf of the council:

Upon the escalating security challenges involving nuclear threats, the Security Council recognizes the need to prevent the spread of nuclear weapons and weapons technology. The Security Council encourages the imperative continuation of the Six Party Talks. The body encourages an incremental approach to nuclear cooperation and recommends the utilization of the Low Enriched Uranium Fuel Bank established by the International Atomic Energy Agency as a site of neutral and responsible storage of low enriched uranium. We commend the progress made by the international community in establishing a mutually beneficial and reliable solution to nuclear storage.

10 The Security Council emphasizes the importance of avoiding inflammatory rhetoric that escalates tensions 11 among parties.
