SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Taking action against gender-related killing of women and girls

SUBMITTED TO: The Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice

The Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice,

1 *Recognizing* the distinct and diverse traditions located in sovereign Member States along with the unique 2 cultural norms,

3 Aware that community based organizations and community leaders have the most direct knowledge of the 4 unique cultural and social history of women in their communities,

5 *Reminding* Member States that all of the efforts should be attempted keeping in mind cultural sensitivity 6 while improving the standard of life,

7 *Noting* the vulnerability of regional communities that do not have access to resources for training local 8 organizations or for the prevention of violence against women,

9 Understanding that cultural norms have a direct impact on gender-based violence that leads to femicide,

10 1. Calls upon Member States to provide substantive aid to people within the most vulnerable communities 11 by working with nonprofits and implementing programs;

12 2. Advises the Economic and Social Council to provide funding for community based nonprofits, and local 13 governments in order to provide resources for at risk women in the communities they reside;

14 3. *Encourages* Member States to connect with community leaders, especially in communities with high rates 15 of femicide;

16 4. Urges Member States to coordinate with the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empow-17 erment of Women as experts in femicide in developing their own culturally sensitive strategies.
