SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Open Agenda

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

The Security Council,

*Deeply concerned* with the Israeli parliamentary decision to ban the United Nations Relief and Works Agency (UNRWA) from Israel and its consequences of limiting humanitarian aid potential in the region,

4 Acknowledging that many NGOs and humanitarian aid groups frequently relied on the UNRWA 5 for logistical coordination, regional cooperation, and operational infrastructure,

6 Noting with concern the recurring attacks on the foreign aid convoys entering Gaza,

*Expressing concern* for the impending famine in Northern Gaza as a result of limited humanitarian capacity,

9 *Recognizing* the risk of disease outbreaks and increased death tolls due to restricted access to 10 medical humanitarian aid,

11 *Cognizant* of the need to develop safe zones for civilians which all parties are aware of and 12 actively avoiding harm towards,

Mindful of the need to maintain access to clean water and sanitation for those suffering the effects of the destruction of their environment in conflict,

15 1. *Channels* the resources allocated to the UNRWA for addressing the humanitarian crisis through 16 the UNICEF Gaza Emergency Fund;

17 2. Establishes a personnel monitoring program under the existing UNICEF monitoring and eval-18 uation framework which encompasses:

(a) Proper background checks, vetting and identity verification of any and all UNICEF
Gaza Emergency Relief Personnel;

(b) Implementing a secure platform for intelligence sharing between UN member states
to facilitate the safety, security and protection of UN organizations;

3. *Urges* the United Nations General Assembly Budgetary Committee to consider increasing UNICEF Gaza Emergency Fund's budget to temporarily increase financial capacity to address the effects of the Israeli ban on the UNRWA;

4. *Calls upon* Member States to assist in building safe zones within areas of conflict for civilians seeking shelter, which include:

- 28 (a) Sanitary facilities;
- 29 (b) Clean water;
- 30 (c) Medical facilities;

(d) And active communication to Member States on the location and status of the cur rent population with the aim to prevent attacks.
