12 13 Recognizing the dire humanitarian and refugee crisis in Chad,

Noting with concern the insufficient amount of medical aid currently being provided to Chad,

Acknowledging the impending crisis in Chad as a result of the conflict in the situation in Darfur,
Sudan,

Recognizing the capacity of air transport to facilitate the provision of humanitarian aid to the region,

- 1. *Invites* the United States, Japan, China and United Kingdom air forces into Chad to provide necessary humanitarian aid, as the two countries have pledged to apply;
 - 2. Utilizes the Adr airstrip And Abeche Airport as center points for the coordination of air transport of humanitarian aid into Chad;
 - 3. Calls for working alongside the currently stationed United Nations High Commissioner of Refugees (UNHCR) to distribute humanitarian aid to refugee camps along the Sudan and Chad border;
 - 4. Continues to invite all parties to provide humanitarian aid whenever possible.
