30th Anniversary Wintrust Magnificent Mile Light Festival

The 30th annual Wintrust Magnificent Mile Light Festival is held on 19 November during the time of our conference registration and Opening Plenary session. Important details you need to know:

- On or around 3:30 p.m. DuSable Bridge (formerly Michigan Avenue Bridge) closes to pedestrian traffic.
- No later than 4:00 p.m. North Michigan Avenue closed to vehicular traffic between Oak Street and Wacker Drive.
- 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. the parade takes place and there is NO pedestrian crossing of Michigan Avenue.
- 6:55 p.m. there are fireworks. Normal traffic on Michigan Avenue will resume some time after 7:00 p.m.
