### **International Press Delegation Services**

The <u>AMUN Chronicle</u> runs as a part of our online blog the <u>AMUN Accords</u>. During Conference, you can sign up via your @amunrep email to receive <u>AMUN Chronicle</u> content at the bottom of any article on the blog or by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

The International Press Delegation offers ways for all representatives to provide content to the AMUN Chronicle. Including:

- Letters to the Editor/Op-Eds: A Letter to the Editor is primarily in response to something that's already been published. An Op-Ed is related to conference as a whole or actual UN, or something topical but unrelated to either (e.g., the hotel's holiday tree).
- **Press Releases:** You're also allowed to release an official statement from your member state on any issue that is topical to the conference as a <u>Press Release</u>.
- **Press Conferences:** Finally, you can apply to host a <u>Press Conference</u> on any topic relevant to your simulation or AMUN topics. There is only a limited number of press conference time slots so make certain you book your time as soon as possible.

#### **AMUN's Home Government Services**

AMUN offers three main services through our Home Government office in the Colorado Room on Level 2.

- Roleplayer Request: Any representative can request a roleplayer for your simulation. Perhaps your committee needs a technical or subject matter expert to help you sort through a complex topic? Or, perhaps your committee wishes to hear from a United Nations body or specialized agency on its efforts related to your agenda topics? Or, perhaps you really need to hear the perspective of a country that is not represented at AMUN this year? In all of these cases, Home Government is available to help.
- **Briefing Request:** Any representative can submit a request for an in-depth briefing on any conference relevant topic to Home Government.
- Information Request: Any representative can submit a request for an answer to a specific research question on any conference relevant topic to Home Government. Home Government Secretariat members will research and email a response to you at your representative email address.

You can utilize these services by making a request through the Rapporteurs or Simulation Staff in your committee/council.
